January 28 - February 4 Global Leadership course, Big Island, Hawai'i. We will travel to Pu'u Wa'awa'a on the Big Island to take part in a global leadership course for high school students from O'ahu.

February, March, April The Tracking Project Institute. Together with our staff and advisors, we are laying the groundwork for an expansion of our programs which will allow us to share more information, bring more people together and reach more people around the world.

April (dates to be determined) **Haiku 'Aina Permaculture Institute, Haiku, Maui.** We will join our friends at HAPI for a continuation of our work with this permaculture / organic food project on Maui.

May 20 - 27 Nurturing the Roots: New Mexico II (NTR/NM) , Cuba, New Mexico. We move into the third and final year of this three year mentor program with artists and educators from around the country at the Circle A Ranch. (This program is by invitation only.)

***June** (dates to be determined) **Ganondagan State Historic Site, Victor, New York.** A weekend tracking class, "ideal for hikers, hunters, outdoor enthusiasts and those interested in learning about the human connection to the natural world through Nature and indigenous values." *** July 8 - 15 Hawkeye Training, Cuba, New Mexico.** A week-long skills camp for boys ages 12-18, held near Cuba, New Mexico. Skills include tracking, survival, Nature awareness, music, story, dance, comedy and the martial arts.
